### TEACHING LICENSURE PROGRAM:

Mackintosh Academy is offering the opportunity for college graduates to obtain a Colorado Teaching License (Certification) in elementary education through a 10-month program. You will be enrolled in the Friends' School Alternative Teacher Preparation Program, which is in conjunction with the State Department of Education and the University of Colorado Denver. The cost of the Teacher Preparation Program is \$8750.

Mackintosh Academy School will cover the cost of the tuition. A \$3000 stipend will be offered by Mackintosh Academy in addition to tuition. Medical and dental benefits are also available.

### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

**Title:** Teacher Candidate

**Time Period:** 2017-2018 Academic Year

Teacher candidates spend one full school year working in a K-6<sup>th</sup> classroom alongside a mentor teacher four days a week and attend workshops/seminars at Friends' School on Fridays. Candidates gradually assume more teaching responsibility until they move into a co-teaching role. A support team provides feedback and advice throughout the internship year. ### MASTER'S DEGREE OPTION:

Candidates also have the option of receiving a Master of Arts in Education and Human Development with a concentration in Human Learning & Development, Early Literacy, Early Childhood or Early Childhood Special Education through a partnership with the University of Colorado Denver at a significantly reduced tuition rate. ### QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must have BA/BS degree. Some training or experience with children is desirable. Must also apply to, and be approved by, the Colorado Department of Education. See "CDE Requirements" under Teacher Preparation Program link of Friends' School website. Passing score on Praxis test is required.
