CHESS CLASS WITH NATIONAL MASTER JOSHUA ROMERO (new this year!)

This class is appropriate for all levels of players. Each class is divided into three sections: instruction, chess playing, and a fun activity. For beginners, we will be learning such topics as piece values, opening principles, middlegame principles, and simple endgames. We will also learn basic checkmates. For intermediate-advanced chess players who already understand how the pieces move, how to castle, and how to get checkmate, we will be learning such topics as modern opening theory, converting positional advantages into material advantages, and how to achieve checkmate against a lone king with all combinations of pieces. Most importantly, we will learn proper etiquette and sports psychology to become good winners as well as good losers.
