Position Description:

The program emphasizes an experiential approach to physical education through a balance of: physical activity, cooperation/participation over competition, development of motor skills, lifetime fitness activities, and delivery of a diverse program that helps students develop skills in a broad-range of sports and activities. We emphasize ad value participation and personal growth over competition.
- This position does not require a coaching commitment, but the willingness to provide afterschool enrichment classes/sports would be a benefit and would result in additional pay.
- Facilitates the social and emotional development of the students. Key components for PE classes would be: class agreements, rituals and routines, class meetings, and leadership opportunities. The successful candidate will have the ability to tailor the curriculum to students with a variety of talents and interests.
- Responsible for facilitating and maintaining PE materials/equipment for formal and informal use.
- Maintains solid frequent and effective communication with home, colleagues and administration.
- Participates in staff meetings, retreats, and on various committees.
- The ideal candidate will have previous PE teaching experience, understand the benefits of an independent elementary and middle school education, and be able to inspire others about Mackintosh's mission, program, culture and community.
